Oregon Library Association's Equity, Diversity, Inclusion and Antiracism (EDIA) Committee is looking to support library-service related professional development with scholarships\*, open to library staff (employed, unemployed, volunteers) in all library types <u>in Oregon</u> who:

- identify as belonging to one or more marginalized, minoritized, and racialized communities seeking general professional development\*\*;
- looking to develop skills in providing culturally relevant services to communities that are historically and currently underserved and under-resourced\*\* OR,
- seeking professional development on, related to or impacting efforts towards equity, diversity, inclusion and/or antiracism in their libraries or the communities they serve

\*Scholarships are made possible in whole by the Institute of Museum and Library Services through the Library Services and Technology Act, administered by the State Library of Oregon \*\* Applications will be given priority

- The learning event must begin before the end of July 2025
- All scholarship recipients must complete a short post-evaluation provided by the State Library of Oregon
