

OLA LIOLA Application & LIOLA Scholarship FAQ

Who is eligible to apply for LIOLA and for LIOLA scholarship funds?

Eligible applicants:

1. currently work in a library,
2. are current members of OLA, and
3. have three (3) years of library work experience.

Can I still apply if I do not have a library degree?

Yes. LIOLA supports the leadership development of all OLA members at any phase in their career.

I applied to be a LIOLA participant previously, but was not accepted. Do I need to reapply to be considered for LIOLA this year?

Yes. LIOLA encourages individuals to reapply.

What is the application deadline and when can I expect to hear something back from the LIOLA Committee?

The LIOLA application process will be open until April 15, 2021. Applicants can expect to hear back from the LIOLA Committee by May 1 on LIOLA acceptance and any scholarship funds awarded (if requested).

Who reviews the LIOLA application?

Members of the LIOLA committee review applications and scholarship requests. All information is kept confidential.

When and where will LIOLA be held?

LIOLA will be held virtually, using Zoom, from 9:00 am - 4:00 pm on July 27, 28, 29 and 30.

How much is it to attend LIOLA?

Cost for participants will be \$250, which includes curriculum materials and training. Scholarships are available to offset the cost of LIOLA.

How much LIOLA scholarship funding is available to me?

Up to \$250 per person.

Do I have to fill out two different applications for LIOLA and LIOLA scholarship funds?

No. There is a single application to apply to be a participant in LIOLA and (if needed) to request LIOLA scholarship funds.

Can I apply for funding from other sources to help cover the cost of LIOLA, in addition to requesting LIOLA scholarship funding?

Yes, you can request funds from your employer, another OLA unit (e.g. CSD, ACRL, OASL, etc.), or other funding sources available to you.

If I get professional development funding from the institution for which I work, will my scholarship application even be considered?

Yes, but financial need is one of the factors considered when determining the awarding of scholarship funds. Your application will be weighted lower than someone with no financial support from their institution.

How will my LIOLA application and request for LIOLA scholarship funds be evaluated?
