- Laural: Queer literature class is in progress, hopes to be ready in October or November. Training clerks to be library assistants. Piloted a cohort of new hires and getting ready for the next cohort. Also updating the African American Literature class.
- Darci: Wrapped this fiscal year's Libraries Leading with Equity training sessions, most recently with 2 ½ day in-person "intensive" for school library staff, with trainer Christina Fuller Gregory. Internal planning for the next cohorts will start soon.
